



Using Atomberg Fan with Google Home

**Google Home app should be installed even before the fan is set up in the Atomberg App, else, user will have to remove the fan from Atomberg App and reset using step 4 of "Steps to add fan in the Atomberg App" from "Concern regarding Atomberg App" brochure.

- Atomberg fan can be controlled using voice commands with the help of Google Assistant. (by both device or by application)
- To set up Google home connection with Atomberg fan, we need to confirm that Atomberg fan and Google home are connected to the same network and Google home is linked to smartphone on which fan is also connected.
- To set up Atomberg fan on Google home app, we need to activate service on Google home app.
- In Google home app, go on profile tab.
- Go to Settings.
- Go to Assistant tab.
- Select home control.
- Click on add (+) button at the bottom left of the screen.
- Search for "Smart life".
- Enter user login ID and password which user used in the app for authentication.
- Atomberg fan is now set up to be used with Google home.

sample commands to use with Google Assistant are given below please check

Ok google switch on/off
Atomberg Fan....

Ok google, set Atomberg fan
at level 1 / 2 / 3 / 4 / 5 / 6
(6 is for Boost Mode)...

Ok google, set Atomberg fan
at low (Level 1) / medium
(Level 3) / high speed (Level
6, i.e., Boost Mode).
