








Is Your Fan Making Noise?

<p>1 STEP</p>	<p>Ensure that the mounting plate assembly has been installed properly on a flat wall surface. Also, ensure that the plastic nut for blade & grill has been tightened properly as shown in the image.</p>  <p style="text-align: center;"><small>Anticlockwise-Tight Clockwise-Loose</small></p>
<p>2 STEP</p>	<p>In case of heavy vibration, switch on the fan by removing the blade to crosscheck if the problem is with the blade or with the motor assembly. In either case, kindly contact Atomberg's Service Team.</p>  <p style="text-align: center;"><small>Without Blade With Blade</small></p>
<p>3 STEP</p>	<p>Install the blade according to the provided pin-slot with the blade pin as shown in image.</p> 
<p>4 STEP</p>	<p>Ensure that the rubber base of your fan is present, so that the vibration could be prevented.</p> 
<p>5 STEP</p>	<p>If the problem continues to persist, then re-install the fan according to the standard procedure shown in the image.</p>  <p style="text-align: right;"><small>61 mm Fan body back hook Hanging plate (Figure 1) (Figure 2)</small></p>
