






# Is Your Fan Making Noise?

<h1 style="color: yellow;">2</h1> <h2>STEP</h2>	<p>Check whether any part is opened or unclipped from the fan assembly (Example in figure) If it is just press tightly so it will not create noise.</p>																	
<h1 style="color: yellow;">3</h1> <h2>STEP</h2>	<p>If the fan is mounted on aluminum window bracket check if it does not have any gaps between fan and body (As it may create noise in the fan)</p>																	
<h1 style="color: yellow;">4</h1> <h2>STEP</h2>	<p>All the screws used to fasten or mount fan on place must be properly tight ensure that nothing is loose.</p>
